



Conflict Minerals Statement

Puritas Metal Products, Inc. is committed to supporting responsible sourcing of minerals throughout our global supply chain. In August 2012, the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") issued final rulings implementing the provisions of Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act ("Dodd-Frank Act").

As a result, we are required to comply to these rulings in which prohibits certain minerals, consisting of gold or columbite-tantalite (coltan) cassiterite, woframite, or their derivatives, which are initially limited to tin, tungsten and tantalum ("3TG"), originating in the Democratic Republic of CONGO ("DRC").

We require Suppliers to certify that their materials are "DRC conflict free", those that have not been able to certify this have been removed from our approved supplier list.

Puritas continues to focus on the importance of business practices that support sourcing of conflict free minerals throughout implementation of ongoing compliance actions where appropriate in our products.

Puritas Metal Products, Inc., will continue to evaluate our practices to ensure compliance with the Dodd-Frank Act requirements and require our suppliers to continue to certify that all "3TG" if any required for production, are sourced outside the Covered Countries.
